Junior Fell Race



Get your dancing shoes ready for this year's school disco at Grindleford Primary School.


Class 1 (R-Y2)	6.00-7.00pm

Bring your buckets and spades and come and have a play on Grindleford's very own beach!


Saddle up! It wouldn't be the seaside without donkey rides.


